This Data Privacy Notice explains how Halpin Wealth Management Ltd collects, uses, stores and protects your personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR") and the Data Protection Act 2018.

The supervisory authority in Ireland is the Data Protection Commission (DPC).

For the purposes of data protection law, Halpin Wealth Management Ltd is the data controller of your personal data.

Halpin Wealth Management LTD respects the rights of data subjects in all interactions including users of our website and is committed to protecting your privacy at all times in accordance with data protection legislation.

Security of data

Halpin Wealth Management LTD takes seriously its security obligations in respect of your personal data under the Data Protection Act and the GDPR with regards to protection and keeping it secure, to prevent unauthorised access to, alteration, loss or destruction of all personal data in our possession.

How we obtain your personal information

You provide us with your personal information directly when you contact us, complete our forms, speak with us or visit our website, and social media accounts. We also get personal information from solicitors, employers, or regulators (where relevant). We also create new personal information about you based on information you have given us and through your interactions with us as well as noting your online preferences.

Please note that where you provide us with your personal information, either directly to us or through a facility provided on our website, we will process and administer your personal data in accordance with this Data Privacy Notice and applicable data protection law. This includes:

- Processing your personal data to perform all necessary actions to give effect to your request or instruction; and
- Retaining a record of incoming and outgoing communications (e.g., phone, email, post or text message).

Information in the communications we receive and send will not be disclosed to any third party without the permission of the sender unless otherwise stated in this Data privacy Notice or in accordance with the Irish Data Protection Act and the GDPR.

For more detailed information on what personal information is collected and how it is used when using our website please see later in this document.

Collection and use of personal data

We collect and use personal information to:

- Arrange transactions on your behalf as agreed with you,
- To service our customers.
- Assist with claims and the payment of plan benefits.

We ensure that all personal data is collected and used on a lawful basis, in accordance with the GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018.

Lawful Basis for Processing Your Personal Data

Under GDPR, we must have a lawful basis to process your personal data. In the course of providing regulated financial advice and services, Halpin Wealth Management Ltd relies on the following lawful bases:

Contract: to provide financial advice, arrange products, administer plans and provide ongoing servicing to you.

Legal Obligation: to comply with laws and regulations including Anti-Money Laundering legislation, Central Bank of Ireland requirements, tax reporting obligations, record keeping, and regulatory compliance.

Legitimate Interests: to manage our business effectively, improve our services, maintain records, carry out internal compliance monitoring, and communicate with existing clients about relevant financial reviews and services.

Consent: we rely on your consent only where required by law, such as:

- Direct marketing communications where you are not an existing client
- Certain website cookies and tracking technologies

Where we rely on consent, you may withdraw it at any time.

Consent and How to Withdraw Consent

Where processing is permitted because the data subject has given consent to the processing for one or more specific purposes. Such consent must be “opt-in”, freely given and clearly understood. If we process your personal information based on consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. The opt-out methods offered will depend on how the consent was collected and will be explained when you give us your consent, e.g., you can change your mind using the opt-out link in any direct marketing emails sent to you however, you will also be able to withdraw consent by contacting us directly.

Needed for your contract

We need to collect and use your personal information to provide your plan contract. This includes, but is not limited to, your name, date of birth, contact and bank account details. Depending on the plan type this can include health, employment, pension and salary information. We restrict access to, and use of, any sensitive personal information. We also create new personal information. In order to receive financial advice from us, you must give personal and financial information for your current and future needs to be assessed. This enables us to recommend the most suitable financial product for you. This also involves creating new and assumed personal information about you. We complete an analysis of you using your personal information to comply with regulations. When you give us your personal information we will check to see if we already have a record of you. This helps us to comply with your Data Protection Rights.

Personal information needed for plan contracts is held and used to (but not limited to)

- process your application
- set up and issue your plan

- provide you with information about your plan (we use your plan and contact details)
- to help the administration of your plan and assist with the payment of your plan benefits
- You must give us your tax residence information and tax identification number for tax reporting with product producers.
- provide customer care and service; and
- contact you to inform you of any relevant actions you may need to take.

Required By Law

We use your personal information to comply with law and regulations such as

- reporting to regulators
- keeping proper books and records; and
- we carry out internal reporting, quality checking, compliance controls and audits to help meet these obligations.

We must collect certain personal information to comply with anti-money laundering law. This depends on your plan type; to do this, we use personal information including your name, date of birth, address, nationality and occupation information.

- Up-to-date proof of identification and address.
- Screening of all customers against Financial Sanctions and Politically Exposed Persons (PEP) lists.
- Where needed, we carry out searches of publicly available information

Legitimate Interest

We use your personal information for our legitimate interests as shown below. This doesn't affect your data protection and privacy rights. We believe these uses benefit our customers. You can contact us if you have any questions using the above contact details of this Data Privacy Notice.

- Statistical Analysis: We combine and group personal information for analysis to help us understand our customers and develop better services for you.
- We use summary information to help promote our services and products from our product providers.
- We use our customer personal information, including yours, to identify the target market for our regulated services.

To Whom do we Pass your Personal Information

We share your personal data with third parties only where necessary to provide our services to you or where required by law.

These include:

- Life assurance companies
- Investment and pension providers
- Financial planning, compliance and CRM software providers
- Anti-Money Laundering and identity verification providers
- Cloud storage, document management and email hosting providers
- Secure communication and virtual meeting platform providers
- Technology providers, including AI-enabled software used to support service delivery.

We do not rely on your consent to share this data where it is necessary for contract performance or legal obligations.

We may pass your personal data on to third-party service providers contracted to Halpin Wealth Management Ltd in the course of

dealing with you. Any third parties that we may share your data with are obliged to keep your details securely, and to use them only to fulfil the service they provide on your behalf. When they no longer need your data to fulfil this service, they will dispose of the details in line with Halpin Wealth Management Ltd procedures.

If we wish to pass your sensitive personal data onto a third party we will only do so once we have obtained your explicit consent, unless we are legally required to do otherwise.

If we transfer personal data to a third party or outside the EU we as the data controller will ensure the recipient (processor or another controller) has provided the appropriate safeguards and on condition that enforceable data subject rights and effective legal remedies for you the data subject are available.

Some of your data may be processed and stored outside the EU by 3rd party providers such as Microsoft, Mailchimp, Docusign or Adobe.

How long do we keep your personal information for?

We retain personal data for as long as you have active policies or an ongoing client relationship with us. Following the end of the client relationship, we will retain your personal data for a minimum of six years in line with regulatory and legal requirements, after which it will be securely deleted or anonymised unless we are required to retain it for a longer period under law.

What are your rights?

You have a number of rights over your personal information which you can exercise free of charge by contacting us using the details in this Data Privacy Notice. You will need to give us some personal information to help us identify you and we will respond to you within one month in line with current regulations. Any

restrictions to your rights will be explained in our response.

Right to Information

You have a right to the information set out in this Data Privacy Notice. We will inform you of our updated Data Privacy Notice, if we change the type of personal information we collect and / or how we use it. We have controls in place to protect your personal information and minimise the risk of security breaches. However, should any breaches result in a high risk for you, we will inform you without delay.

Right to Restrict or Object

You can restrict or object to any unfair and unlawful collection or use of your personal information. You can object to any automated decision making that has a legal or similar significant impact for you and ask for the decision to be made by a person. You can withdraw consent and object to, for example direct marketing.

Right to Correct and Update

You can ask us to correct and update personal information we hold about you. Your plans are long term contracts and to provide you with the best service it is important we have your up-to-date personal information, such as contact details. We are not required to rectify or erase your data where to do so would prevent you from meeting your contractual obligations to us or where we are required to process (including retaining) your personal data for a lawful purpose in accordance with the GDPR (2016/679) and the Irish Data Protection Act 2018.

Right to Delete and Be Forgotten

You can have your personal information deleted if it is incorrect or has been processed unfairly or unlawfully. If you have withdrawn consent, you can ask for your personal information to be deleted. We will keep a record of your request, so we know why your personal information was deleted. If we have provided a

regulated product or service to you, we must keep your personal information for a minimum period by law. This does not affect the requirement to hold your information for the purposes of fulfilling a contract.

Right to Portability

You can ask for a copy of all personal information that you gave us (including through your interactions with us), and which we hold in an automated format. You can receive this in a machine-readable format that allows you to keep it. You may also request us to send this personal information in a machine-readable format to another company. The format will depend on our ability to provide this in a secure way that protects your personal information. We will not likely be able to use a copy of your personal information sent to us in this way from another company. This is because we can only collect personal information that we need. We also need your most up to date personal information for underwriting and to comply with regulations.

Right to Access

You have the right to know what personal information we hold about you and to receive a copy of your personal information. We must tell you,

- why we hold it,
- who we pass it to, including whether we transfer it outside the EU.
- how long we keep it for,
- where we got it from; and
- We do not make decisions about you based solely on automated processing without human involvement.

This right does not allow you to access personal information about anyone else. To access your personal information please write to us using the contact details in this Data Privacy Notice. To help us respond as quickly as possible please let us know if you are only looking for copies of specific personal information or a complete copy of your client file.

We use "cookies" to collect information. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our services.

This site uses different types of cookies. Some cookies are placed by third party services that appear on our pages. – Halpin wealth Management Ltd. uses PHPSESSID and Cookieyes- Consent on our website.

You can at any time change or withdraw your consent from the Cookie Declaration on our website.

Web Browsing

When you visit our website, we may collect technical data. This is used for statistical and security purposes and does not identify you personally. All that we may know about your visit may be limited to technical data (log data) such as;

- The logical address (or IP address) of the server you used to access our website
- The top-level domain name from which you access the internet (for example .ie, .com, .org, .net)
- The previous website address from which you reached us
- The type of web-browser you used
- Web traffic data (the amount of data sent and received) by visitors to a web site. This is determined by the number of visitors and the number of pages they visit, specific pages of our website that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics

The technical data may be used for administrative and statistical purposes and may be shared with our internet service provider. We may use this information to help us to improve our website. This technical data does not provide us with the personal data of visitors to our website.
